

9. Sun <i>Križevci</i>	<i>BIBLE: PRAY FOR THE CHURCHES OF SLOVENIA</i> Pray for all the churches of Slovenia. Pray for all the Christian churches who are part of the Bible society (evangelical, catholic, orthodox, Lutheran, etc.) to be founded on the Word of God and to teach the Word in each service.
10. Mon <i>Krško</i>	<i>MEDITATE AND PRAY: EPHESIANS 4:17</i> <i>So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking.</i> – Pray each area of the lives of believers would be lived noticeably differently from the people around them.
11. Tues <i>Kungota</i>	THANKSGIVING, PRAISE AND WORSHIP Ps 50:14-15 <i>Sacrifice thank offerings to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High, and call on me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me.</i> Give thanks to our wonderful Savior; praise and worship Him with your mouth and with your obedience in every area of your life.
12. Wed <i>Kuzma</i>	PRAY FOR HUNGER FOR GOD Pray people would be so desperate for truth that they would read their Bible, come to an evangelical church, or start a conversation with a believer about spiritual things.
13. Thur <i>Laško</i>	<i>MEDITATE AND PRAY: EPHESIANS 4:18</i> <i>They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts.</i> – Pray for people you know apart from Christ based on this verse.
14. Fri <i>Lenart</i>	RECONCILIATION A Slovene pastor recently said, “What we need is for each of us to go to people they have offended and ask forgiveness.” Pray for courage for all believers to be actively seeking reconciliation.
15. Sat <i>Litija</i>	SLOVENE GOVERNMENT: 1 Tim 2:2; Prov 29:16 Pray for the new Slovene government, for wisdom and fairness in the parliament, for honest, upright candidates, for wisdom for the voters.
16. Sun <i>Ljubno</i>	<i>PRAY FOR THE CHURCHES OF SLOVENIA</i> Pray for God’s blessing on Slovene churches today. Pray for children raised in Christian homes to make their faith their own.

17. Mon <i>Ljutomer</i>	<i>MEDITATE AND PRAY: EPHESIANS 4:19</i> <i>Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed.</i> – Pray for the Slovene nation in light of this verse.
18. Tues <i>Log-Dragomer</i>	MENTAL PROBLEMS IN EUROPE Researchers from The European College of Neuropsychopharmacology (ENCP) say a third of Europeans suffer from mental (depression, insomnia, anxiety) or neurological disorders (Parkinson's, dementia) each year. Pray for those who need medical help to get it, and for all to find true peace in the Lord; for those who need forgiveness, for those who need to extend forgiveness, for some to remove themselves from certain situations. www.presstv.ir/detail/197574.html
19. Wed <i>Logatec</i>	<i>UNITY PROCLAIMS THE GOSPEL</i> John 17:23 The Christian life is a race, but a race where we run together. Pray we would live in the reality of our unity in Christ to win the world. www.europeanea.org
20. Thur <i>Loška Dolina</i>	<i>MEDITATE AND PRAY: EPHESIANS 4:20-21</i> <i>That, however, is not the way of life you learned when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus.</i> – Ponder the way God describes the life the believer should live.
21. Fri <i>Loški Potok</i> www.lausanne.org	“THE WHOLE CHURCH TAKING THE WHOLE GOSPEL TO THE WHOLE WORLD” This was a key vision statement from the Lausanne world evangelism congress last October. The international director of the Lausanne movement, Lindsay Brown, is visiting Slovenia this month. Pray for a fresh vision for what the church is and what the church can and should do.
22. Sat <i>Lovrenc na Pohorju</i>	BIBLICAL CONFLICT RESOLUTION Pray that we will remember that success in God's eyes is not a matter of specific results, but of faithful, dependent obedience. Pray that our service as peacemakers will bring praise to our Lord and lead others to know His infinite love (Matt. 25:14-21; John 13:34-35; Rom. 12:18; 1 Peter 2:19; 4:19).
23. Sun <i>Luče</i>	<i>PRAY FOR THE CHURCHES OF SLOVENIA</i> Pray for God’s blessing on Slovene churches today. Pray for God's people to give generously to meet the financial needs of the church, the pastor, and for outreach.

24. Mon <i>Lukovica</i>	REFORMATION DAY IS OCT. 31: PRAISE Praise God for the work of Slovenia's reformers (Trubar, Dalmatin, etc.) not only for what it means to Slovene culture, language and identity, but for God's truth that they brought.
25. Tues <i>Majšperk</i>	REFORMATION: AWARENESS Pray for media to be interested in the message of the Reformation. Pray that believers in Slovenia would have opportunities to talk about Trubar and the Reformation with people, and thus to share the Gospel.
26. Wed <i>Makole</i>	READ TRUBAR? FEW HAVE. www.primoztrubar.si When Nick Vujcic asked thousands of Slovenes in April if they had read Trubar only a few said yes. Pray for people who heard Nick to read Trubar and be changed by the Gospel message.
27. Thur <i>Markovci</i>	REFORMATION: FIRST PRINTED SENTENCE Pray that people would understand Trubar's deep desire for all Slovenes of all time: <i>For all Slovenes I pray grace, peace, mercy and the true knowledge of God through Jesus Christ.</i>
28. Fri <i>Medvode</i>	FRIENDLY CONVERSATION WITH GOD - PRAYER Trubar wrote that "Prayer is friendly conversation with God." Pray that Slovenes would truly seek God in sincere, personal prayer.
29. Sat <i>Mengeš</i>	"STAND AND WITHSTAND" – Trubar, Katekizem 1550 <i>With such faith the Christian and stand and withstand in trials and temptations and stand against the lack of faith in our flesh.</i> Pray Slovenes would understand this famous phrase (it's on the Slovene €1 coin!) – that faith in God the key to truly standing and withstanding in life.
30. Sun <i>Metlika</i>	REFORMATION DAY / HALLOWEEN – OCTOBER 31 Halloween costumes, candy, decorations and celebrations continue to eclipse Reformation Day in Slovenia. Pray for the media and businesses to turn away from the focus on witches and darkness to honor the rich spiritual heritage of Europe.
31. Mon <i>Mežica</i>	TURNING TO THE LIVING GOD Pray for people who will go to Slovenia's cemeteries tonight before the 'day of the dead' to honor dead family and friends to hear God's voice and turn to Him

1. Sat <i>Kobarid</i>	MUNICIPALITIES WITHOUT EVANG. CHURCHES ◀ Pray daily for the municipalities listed. Pray for people from these unreached areas to come to Christ and reach their neighbors.
2. Sun <i>Kobilje</i>	PRAY FOR JERUSALEM www.daytopray.com Sunday October 2nd is the international day of prayer for Israel: "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem" (Ps 122:6). Pray for all who live in Israel, for peace, for God's truth to spread there.
3. Mon <i>Komen</i>	BIBLE MARATHON: www.svetopisemskimaraton.si The Slovene Bible Society and Christian denominations are hosting a Bible reading marathon 24 hours a day, October 2-9. Pray people would be touched by the power of the Word.
4. Tues <i>Komenda</i>	TAKE TIME TO MEDITATE ON THIS VERSE AND PRAY ACCORDINGLY: EPH. 4:15 <i>Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.</i> – Pray for biblical truth and love to reign between believers. Pray that we would all mature in faith in this.
5. Wed <i>Kostanjevica na Krki</i>	BIBLE: PERSONAL READING Pray that ordinary Slovenes would read their Bible today, and that the Lord would speak to them through it. Pray Bible reading would become a daily habit for them.
6. Thur <i>Kostel</i>	MEDITATE AND PRAY: EPHESIANS 4:16 <i>From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.</i> – Pray for the body of Christ to function together as a healthy body, with each part fulfilling its God-given role.
7. Fri <i>Kozje</i>	BIBLE: BIBLE STUDY Pray for more Bible study groups in Slovenia, and for people to apply the Bible to their lives.
8. Sat <i>Kranjska Gora</i>	BIBLE: BIBLE SOCIETY Pray for the work of the Slovene Bible society. Pray for creativity in bringing the word of God to people.
